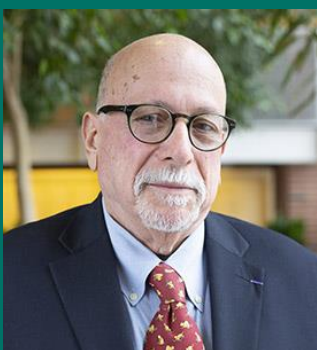


Faculty Freedom Today
